
Standardization - It's the Law!



Defense Standardization Program is Required by Law

Defense Cataloging & Standardization Act Title 10, U.S. Code Chapter 145 Section 2451-2457 (Approved July 1, 1952)

- Establishes a single, unified standardization program in DoD
- Requires standardization of items used throughout
 DoD to the highest degree practicable
- Requires standardization and interoperability of equipment with North Atlantic Treaty Organization members and other countries





Public Law and Federal Regulation



- Public Law 104-113, "National Technology Transfer and Advancement Act," March 7, 1996
 - Preference for developing and using non-government standards instead of government specifications and standards
- OMB Circular A-119, Federal Participation in the Development and Use of Voluntary Consensus Standards and in Conformity Assessment Activities
 - All Federal agencies must use voluntary consensus standards in lieu of government-unique standards in their procurement and regulatory activities



Public Law and Federal Regulation



(continued)

- Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) paragraph 11.101(b) on Order of Precedence for Requirements Documents
 - "In accordance with OMB Circular A-119, and Section 12(d) of the NTTA of 1995, Pub. L. 104-113 (15 U.S.C. 272 note), agencies must use voluntary consensus standards, when they exist, in lieu of Government-unique standards, except where inconsistent with law or otherwise impractical."

FAR paragraph 11.102

Agencies shall select existing requirements documents or develop new requirements documents that meet the needs of the agency in accordance with the guidance contained in the Federal Standardization Manual, FSPM-0001; for DoD components, DoD 4120.24-M, Defense Standardization Program Policies and Procedures...

• FAR paragraph 11.201(a)

- Identifies the DoD Acquisition Streamlining and Standardization Information System (ASSIST) as a source for specifications and standards cited in a solicitation
 - Note: ASSIST was developed by DSPO for the electronic indexing and distribution of DSP documents.



DSP Documents



- Commercial Item Description (CID) Defines requirements for commercially available items
- Data Item Description (DID) Provides content and format requirements for data deliverables listed on Contract Data Requirements Lists (CDRL)
- Defense Standard Defines requirements for military unique processes, test methods, practices
- Defense Specification Defines requirements & tests for military unique items
- Federal Specification Defines requirements & tests for federal government unique items




- Federal Standard Defines requirements for federal government unique processes, test methods, practices
- International Standardization Agreement (ISA) an agreement between treaty organization nations to standardize on interfaces, material, parts, equipment, etc. for military purposes (e.g., NATO STANAG)
- Military Handbook Provides guidance for selection of items or engineering approaches
- Non-Government Standard (NGS) a standardization document developed by a national or international private sector association, organization, or technical society that plans, develops, establishes, or coordinates standards, specifications, handbooks, and related documents.

The Role of DoD




- Develop and maintain standardization and interoperability policy, procedures and guidance documents
- Contribute to the technical underpinning for standards
- Participate in standards development
 - Through the voluntary process, has an equal seat at the table with other stakeholders
 - Provide U.S. representation to various international standards developing organizations (treaty and non-treaty)
- Implement standards
 - In product purchases (Government Procurement)
 - Through incorporation into regulations, doctrine and tactics

DepSOs



- Plan, direct, advocate, and monitor the DSP in their department or agency
- Assign standardization responsibilities within their department or agency, such as Standardization Management Activities (SMAs)
- Resolve standardization issues in their own department or agency and work
- They may also designate departmental standardization activities (DSAs) for each federal supply group (FSG), federal supply class (FSC), and standardization area



Standardization Management Activities (SMAs)



 SMAs are authorized by their Department/Agency to develop and maintain standardization documents in their area of expertise

They may function as:

- Lead Standardization Activity (LSA)
- Document Preparing Activity (PA)
- Document Adopting Activity
- Document Custodians
- Document Review Activity



SMA Assignments



- DoD standardization management assignments and materiel standards are divided along product and technology lines, and standardization areas
 - The Federal Cataloging System, which organizes products into logical families known as Federal Supply Groups (FSGs), and Federal Supply Classes (FSCs).
 - Technologies, such as human factors, safety, information processing, and nondestructive testing, are organized into standardization areas.
- There are currently 78 FSGs, groups, which are subdivided into 645 FSCs
- There are currently 115 active preparing activities with documents indexed in ASSIST

Background



Indexing Specifications and Standards is vital to the DSP.

- In 1952, Public Law 82-436 established the Defense Standardization Program (DSP)
 - Required the creation of a single set of specifications and standards, which DoD buying activities would use in the procurement of similar items.
- The Congress believed that a single set of specifications and standards would save money and manpower by avoiding duplication of efforts in document preparation and maintenance
- In 1962, the DoD established the DoD Single Stock Point (DoDSSP) to establish a single source for obtaining specifications and standards generated by the DoD.



Purpose of ASSIST



- ASSIST is the official source for standardization documents developed and used by DoD
- It is used by Standardization Management Activities (SMAs) to develop, coordinate and publish standardization documents prepared in accordance with DoD Manual 4120.24
- ASSIST helps to maintain centralized control over the physical and electronic storage, indexing, cataloging, printing and distribution of specifications and standards used by DoD
- Access to ASSIST is available to users that span the globe



Current ASSIST Functionality





ASSIST Program Management



- DSPO
- As the Executive Agent for the DSP, the Director, DSPO has the primary "ownership" responsibility for the ASSIST and provides leadership direction on system functionality
- Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), J6:
 - Serves as the Defense Standardization Program Automation Office (DSPAO)
- Provides automation support for the DSP
- ASSIST Sustainment Contractor



DSPAO



- DSPAO is responsible for operating and maintaining ASSIST:
 - Indexing and publishing new and revised DSP documents submitted by SMAs
 - Ensuring that SMAs have complied with applicable policy and procedures in DoD Manual 4120.24
 - Managing the day-to-day operations of the ASSIST Service Desk
 - Coordinating with DSPO, ASSIST Maintenance (Sustainment) Contractor, users, and other stakeholders on all ASSIST matters

- Create an ASSIST that can expand and grow to address current and future requirements
- Enterprise-wide access to non-government standards
- Allow PAs to update documents in a digital form
- Distribute documents in the form of digital data

What is Qualification



- Process of testing in advance of, and independent of, an acquisition
- Specification driven; stated in section 3
- Manufacturers who have passed the testing requirements are put on a Qualified Product's List (QPL) or Qualified Manufacturers List (QML)
- Buying activities can buy from those approved suppliers without carrying out extensive testing on the products (QPL) or processes (QML) since testing was done in advance




Functions of Qualification



- Shorter Lead Times
 - For acquisitions & procurements
- Reduced Testing Costs and Improved readiness
 - Through continuous availability of reliable products from viable suppliers
- Products, processes, or materials of manufacturers or distributors are independently examined and tested
 - To determine whether they conform to the specification requirements before they are acquired

- Products and manufacturers that successfully pass the qualification are then identified on a list
 - Qualified Products go on Qualified Products Lists (QPLs)
 - Qualified Processes and Materials go on Qualified Manufacturers Lists (QMLs)





Paper-based (PDF) QPLs and QMLs



Prior to 2006, QPLs and QMLs were developed as paper based (PDF) documents

- These documents were...
 - Static
 - Out of date
- This created an unnecessary burden of Qualifying Activities (QAs)
 - Only way to maintain QPLs and QMLs was through lengthy self audits in ASSIST

Qualified Products Database (QPD)



In 2006, QPD went live, changing the way DOD QPLs and QMLs were managed

- Electronic system
- Introduced in 2006
- System tracks retention of qualification
- Database is specification driven
- Address of manufacturers and suppliers via feed from System for Award Management (SAM)
- Allows qualifying activities the ability to manage their QPL's and QML's in a workflow system, in near real time





Qualified Products Database (QPD)



- Allows Qualifying Personnel to manage the Qualification program for their respective service
- 718 QPLs currently in the QPD containing over 13M manufacturers part numbers
- 49 Qualifying Activity Administrators (Highest role)
- 28 Qualifying Activities
- 64 Data-entry personnel
- FY 16 QPD had over 7,800,000 hits



QPD helps Qualifying Activities manage their QPLs and QMLs



QPD Operations



- Must have a spec that calls out qualification in ASSIST in order to create a Qualified Data Set in OPD.
- Qualified Data Sets link back to the governing specification in ASSIST
- A flag in ASSIST on the specific governing specification allows for the creation of a QDS in QPD.
- When qualification is canceled and the verification is returned to a different type of verification testing, the record in QPD must be deleted (same goes with plants)
- Addresses of qualified sources are provided by CAGE Code data pulled from GSA's System for Award Management (SAM).

- WSIT allows users to trace the use of standards and specifications by weapons systems and parts
- With WSIT, users can assess the impact of document changes on weapon systems
- WSIT and Pin Point© work in concert, with Pin Point offering users access to structured data on government-approved component parts across the supply web

WSIT allows program managers to view the impacts standards have on their weapon systems

How WSIT Works

- WSIT allows CAC users the opportunity to see what impact changes in a Spec or Standard would have on weapon systems
- Relates Specs and Standards to NSN and Weapon System
 - Can show what specs and standards are important in a given area
 - Can show what NSNs are good candidates for supply chain evaluation efforts
 - Links directly from ASSIST

How Pin Point Works

- Provides CAC users a query engine for researching parts in the Federal supply chain
- Provides advanced parametric searching on physical and logistic part properties
- Designed to meet objectives of MIL-STD-3018 "Department of Defense Standard Practice – Parts Management"
- A User Interface to the Coherent View database. The Coherent View:
 - aggregates part data from DOD databases, DOD EMALL/FedMall, GSA Advantage and NASA SEWP electronic part portals, and commercial and manufacturer websites
 - uses advanced Artificial Intelligence technology to extract and infer part properties from narrative text, specifications, part numbers, and product descriptions


